Singapore Raptor Report Late Spring Migration 2011 (April-May)

Summary:

A 2-hr period at Tuas from 1600-1845 hrs on 01 April 2011 produced 26 Oriental Honey Buzzards and 9 Japanese Sparrowhawks. Most of the other migrant raptors had already left and we only had 2 Ospreys, another Oriental Honey Buzzard and a few Peregrine Falcons.
