Singapore Raptor Report Spring Migration, February 2013

Summary for migrant species:

A total of 112 migrant raptors of 8 species were recorded in February 2013. This month's 92 **Black Bazas**, was a steep increase compared to last month (10 birds). Notably, a flock of 60 Black Baza was seen by Lim Kim Keang at Pasir Ris Park, on the 17th, flying northerly. Next were the **Oriental Honey Buzzard**, represented by 7 birds, and the **Peregrine Falcon** by 4 birds.

After having gone "missing" in January, three rare **Jerdon's Bazas** appeared at Lorong Halus on the 10th, again recorded by Lim Kim Keang! A dark morph **Booted Eagle** flying over the Gardens by the Bay on the morning of the 15th was a pleasant surprise for Nicholas Tan, who was quick to snap a few photos! Another Booted Eagle was still wintering at Seletar North Link. The remainder of the migrant raptors comprised 2 **Chinese Sparrowhawks**, 1 **Japanese Sparrowhawk** and an **Osprey**.

Highlights for sedentary species: On the 23rd, Alan Owyong recorded a **Crested Goshawk**, a rare resident, at Portsdown Road area. The day after, on the 24th, Horst Flotow recorded not one, but 2 **Crested Serpent Eagles** at Jelutong Tower! A **Grey-headed Fish Eagle** seems to be establishing a presence at Seletar North Link.
